City of Port Huron Announces Tobacco-Free Parks Policy



Port Huron MI- Summer is upon us and the parks are open for the season. In effort to keep our outdoor recreational areas healthy and enjoyable for all. The City of Port Huron will be increasing police enforcement at our beaches to enforce park ordinances. Port Huron has joined many other local jurisdictions in Michigan when it adopted a new tobacco-free ordinance (City Ordinance 36-9) for all parks and beaches. The tobacco-free ordinance 36-9 prohibits the use of tobacco, including e-cigarettes/vapor products, hookah, shisha, chewing tobacco and any form of marijuana. Other ordinances that will be have increased enforcement is littering in the park (City Ord. 36-6), No alcohol (City Ord. 36-8), Vehicles in the grass, and the Canal ordinance. Failure to follow these rules will result in fines and possible removal from the park.
